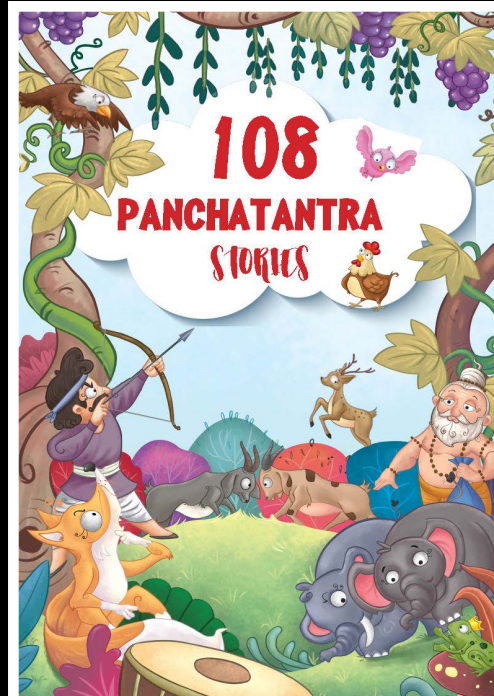
42. THE FEAR-SIGHTED SWAN

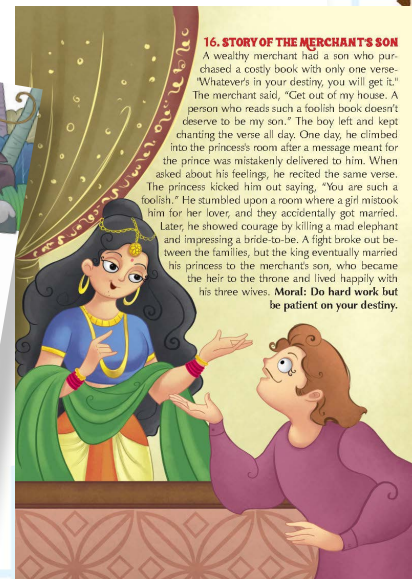

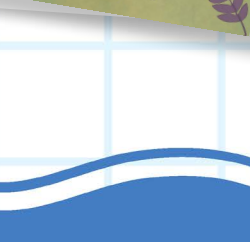
16. STORY OF THE MERCHANT'S SON

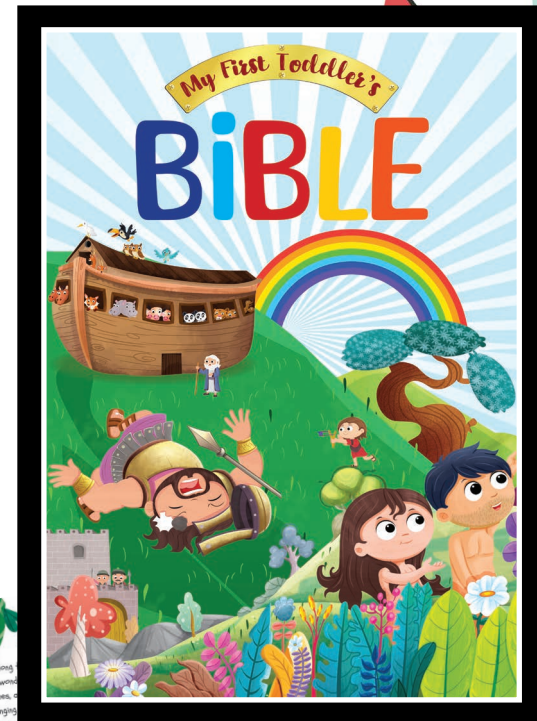
