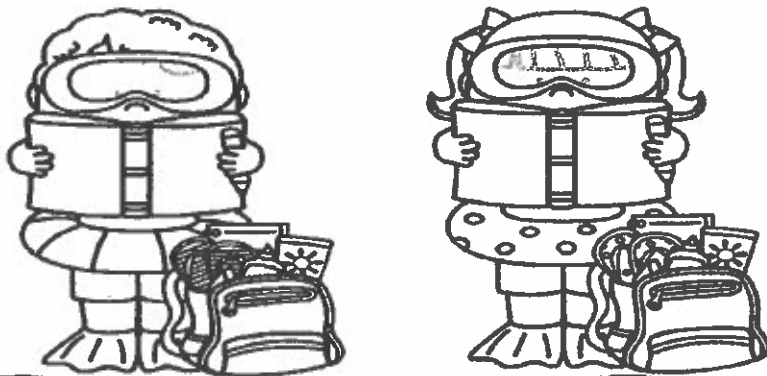
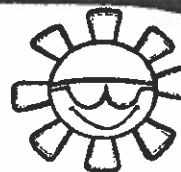


My Summer Reading Packet





Dear Parents,

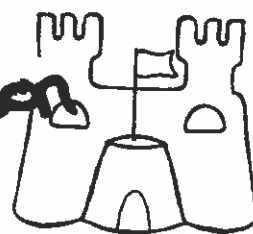
Summer is finally here. Reading during the summer is so important! To help your child retain what he/she learned in Kindergarten, please set aside a reading time each day of about 20 - 30 minutes. During this time, you may read to your child or your child may read to you.

To encourage your child's love of reading, I am sending home this reading packet. Students will record their reading in 3 ways each time -

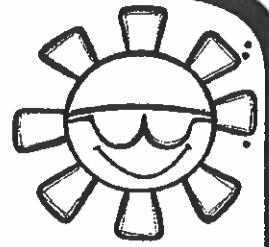
1. Color a square on one of the Bingo cards.

***Feel free to adapt these guidelines to meet the needs of your child. Our main goal is to keep your child excited about reading!

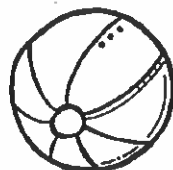
